Destination: Deer Creek

SKILLS

A. Turn Signals

- 1. Turn on turn signal 100 feet before turn in business and residential areas (at least 5 seconds)
- 2. Turn on turn signal 200 feet before turn in rural areas (at least 5 seconds)

B. Roundabouts (Square)

- 1. Stop or yield at correct place
- 2. Determine right-of-way
- 3. Make sure crosswalk and intersection are clear before proceeding
- 4. Select safe gap to join traffic
- 5. Signal intention when getting on roundabout (Square)
- 6. Signal when exiting

C. School Zones

- 1. When flashing yellow in a school zone 20 MPH
- 2. 20 MPH on school days when children are present, even if no flashing yellow light

D. Rural Roadways

- 1. Tracking over grease spot
- 2. Maintain speed at 55 MPH or posted speed, or as conditions allow
- 3. 12-15 second target area
- 4. Orderly visual search pattern
- 5. Recognize all signs and warnings

E. Uncontrolled Railroad Crossing

- 1. Be alert for crossing with no gates or lights
- 2. Look for white cross buck or round yellow railroad sign
- 3. Look both ways as you approach
- 4. Listen for train sounds. Turn down radio and roll down window
- 5. If there is a train coming, stop 15 to 50 feet before the tracks
- 6. When train passes, check for another train

F. Overpasses/Bridges/Ramps

 In icy and snowy conditions, remember bridges, overpasses, and ramps stay icier longer than other parts of the roadway

G. Rural Intersections

- 1. Identify intersection early
- 2. Identify your traffic control and cross traffic's traffic control
- 3. Remember rural driveways are intersections
- 4. When approaching, search and scan intersection
- 5. Slow and stop when necessary
- 6. When turning at rural intersections, slow to 10-15 MPH; yield to oncoming traffic when necessary

H. Angle Parking

- 1. Check behind you in mirror
- 2. Make sure angle parking spot is legal and clear of obstacles and pedestrians
- 3. Position car at least 6 feet from the car you are parking next to
- 4. Cover brake and signal
- 5. As soon as you can look directly down the first line of your parking spot (reference point), turn wheels and look to the center of the parking spot
- 6. Creep forward and stop before tires hit curb
