

Tic-Tac-Toe

Challenge a classmate to a game of tic-tac-toe. The first player picks any of the nine squares and answers the question in it. If the question is answered correctly, an X is placed in the square. The second player then gets to select the next square. An O is entered in the second player's square if the question is answered correctly. Take turns until one player has three squares filled across, down, or diagonally. This player wins the game.
